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Lights and blinds control panel for Conference Room 119




Lights and blinds panels are located on the wall next to each door

- 1 Turn on all lights and raise blinds
- 2 Lower blinds, turn on all lights except the front wall light
- 3 Lower blinds, turn on all lights except the front wall light (repeat of 2)
 - 4 Lower blinds, turn off all lights except back wall light
 - 5 Turn all lights off, raises blinds



Lights and blinds control panel for Conference Room 119

This Lights and blinds panel is located on the wall behind the podium (same as the wall panels)



- 1 Turn on all lights and raise blinds
- 2 Lower blinds and turn on all lights except front wall light
- 3 Lower blinds and turn on all lights except front wall light
- 4 Lower blinds and turn off all lights except back wall light
- 5 Raise blinds and turn off all lights


Open Preset 1 Blind controller is located on 3 Preset 2 the wall behind the podium Preset 3 4 Close 5 6

- 1 Raise blinds
- 2 Lower blinds a quarter of the way
- **3** Lower blinds a quarter of the way (repeat of 2)
- 4 Lower blinds halfway
- **5** Lower blinds
- 6 Manually adjust blinds

Barco allows you to share a screen by plugging in the Barco device to your laptop and clicking a button to share the screen.





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

Solid ring will form when Barco device is ready. Click inside the ring to share the screen.




Ring will turn red while sharing.



Note: 121H is the main room and 121G is the secondary room






Podium Control Panel Rooms Combined



Room 121H Control Panel will automatically separate the rooms if the ceiling sensor is blocked by the room dividers









Locate the divider panels on the side wall in the middle of the room



Locate the crank hanging on the wall next to the divider panels



1. Pull out the first panel and unfold it



2. Slide the panel into position so that it is flush at the far end of the wall



3. Locate the bolt at the back end of the divider panel



4. Place the crank over the bolt and turn clockwise until it stops



5. Pull out and unfold the second panel and slide it into the first panel



7. Place the crank over the bolt and turn clockwise until it stops







8. Pull out and unfold the third panel and slide it into the second panel



9. Locate the bolt at the back end of the third divider panel



10. Place the crank over the bolt and turn clockwise until it stops

11. Pull out and unfold the fourth panel and slide it into the third panel



9. Locate the bolt at the back end of the fourth divider panel



10. Place the crank over the bolt and turn clockwise until it stops



11. Pull out and turn the final panel so that the tension bolt is facing you



12. Slide the final panel into the fourth divider panel



13. Place the crank over the bolt and turn clockwise to close the gap to the wall and secure the divider
